JR. PROM REMINDER

As a reminder for the Prom this Friday. All students attending the Prom need to be in school on Friday, on time. This means being in class for 7:30 am. Understanding the day, students need to remain in school until 11:00. Students being dismissed prior to this time will not be allowed entrance to the Prom. In order for students to be dismissed early on Friday, a parent or guardian must call the school and leave a message in attendance prior to dismissal. Calls made by parents/guardian around dismissal time may not be heard by staff, in turn delaying dismissal for that student. Call early! Signed notes will be accepted as well, but please understand these notes will be verified by staff who will be calling home. Again, this will delay the dismissal process for that student. Not to sound redundant please inform school early, in order to expedite dismissal.

Arrive a little early to Prom, we will be utilizing a random breathalyzer system. Upon entry, all students will pull a Ping Pong Ball from a container. If the ball has a red dot, the student will be breathalyzed. If the ball is blank, the student will be allowed entry. In the case that a student does not pass the breathalyzer, families will be contacted and depending on the situation EMT may be called to respond. Discipline will be handled accordingly, and a follow up meeting with the Principal will be needed. Staff will be on the lookout for behavior/characteristics of substance use. Students who raise this concern, also will be breathalyzed (even if they chose a blank Ping Pong Ball). Finally any and all bags will be searched upon entry.

We, as an institution, value the safety and well-being of every student and these procedures are being put into place in the hope of deterring negative choices and keeping all students safe.
