Instruction - Academic Achievement -

Interim Progress Reports

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Upon parental or guardian request, students shall be given a separate written progress report for each requested subject at least once every two weeks for a quarter of the school year until directed otherwise by the parents or guardians. Information regarding tests, quizzes, homework, attitude, conduct and any other relevant matters shall be included in the report.

The reports shall be signed by the parents or guardians and returned promptly to the teacher(s) on or before a date specified by the teacher.

After consultation with the parents or guardians, the teacher may discontinue making interim progress reports if the report(s) is not properly signed and returned to the teacher on the specified date. At the end of the quarter during which the interim reports were requested, the parents or guardians shall be advised in writing by the principal or guidance counselor that the reports shall be discontinued in the ensuing quarters unless a new request for interim progress reports is made.
