Instruction Academic Achievement -

Grading and Reporting

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The administration and professional staff shall devise grading and reporting systems for evaluating and recording student progress. The records and reports of individual students shall be kept in a form that will be meaningful to parents/ guardians, as well as teachers. The grading and reporting systems shall be uniform throughout the system, at comparable grade levels.

The School Committee shall approve the grading and reporting system, as developed by staff, upon recommendation of the Superintendent.

The School Committee recognizes that any grading system, however effective, is subjective in nature, and urges all faculty members to conduct student evaluation as objectively as possible.

A written report shall be provided for all parents/guardians four (4) times each school year, with supplementary reports as needed. These shall be required for students in danger of failing.

Conferences with parents/guardians shall be used as an integral part of the reporting system.
