Instruction Curriculum Policies - Curriculum

Steering Committee

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A well-coordinated curriculum is a foundation for a good educational program and a critical factor in student achievement. The Newport School Department is committed to the development of an overall curriculum plan for the education of its students that defines standards of knowledge and skills for subject areas, establishes links among subjects, and provides for articulation between levels of schooling.

Curriculum Steering Committee shall be established in to insure articulation among school levels. This committees shall consist of classroom teachers from the elementary, middle and senior high schools. They shall meet periodically with the Director of Curriculum and Instruction to review the status of curriculum coordination and shall recommend changes to the Superintendent of Schools when needed.

All proposals for recommended changes in the curriculum shall be reviewed by these committees before implementation.
