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School Committee members are encouraged to prepare themselves for maximum service to the community through:

- a. Conferences with other School Committee members.
- b. Conferences with the Superintendent.
- c. Visits to observe administrative office practices.
- d. Membership in the Rhode Island Association of School Committees and the National School Boards Association.
- e. Visits to schools as a committee or individually.
- f. Participation in curriculum committee studies.
- g. Attendance and participation at educational conferences and conventions, particularly the meetings of the Rhode Island Association of School Committees and National School Boards Association.
- h. Reading educational magazines and periodicals.
- i. Appearances at Parent-Teacher Association, civic and church group meetings.
- j. Study of the bylaws of the School Committee.
- k. Familiarization with departmental policies, regulations, and staff job descriptions.
- l. Accessing meaningful Professional Development opportunities whenever presented.
