Newport Public Schools Article I – Appointments

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Sub-committee Chairs and members; Liaison representatives shall be appointed annually. Should the School Committee desire that community representatives be part of standing Subcommittees or members of Ad Hoc Committees established by the School Committee, community membership will be solicited through public notification on the Newport School Department website, parent list servs, and at School Committee Meetings.

Community members would be required to submit a letter of interest and a brief statement outlining their relevant experience and background for the Subcommittee/Ad Hoc Committee in which they wish to participate.

The School Committee Chair and Subcommittee/Ad Hoc Committee Chair will review the letters and recommended candidates to the School Committee.

The Newport School Committee, as a body, will review the recommended letters of interest and officially appoint community members to those Committees.

The Superintendent, in his/her position, of Clerk of the Newport School Committee, shall publicize the position of Legal Counsel for the School Committee. Said Legal Counsel for the School Committee shall be appointed after the Regular meeting of the December Meeting after the election of the School Committee Members.
